Physician Retraining & Reentry

Presented in collaboration with UC San Diego School of Medicine faculty, Physician Retraining & Reentry (PRR) is an online educational program designed to address the growing shortage of primary care physicians. The program empowers physicians of all backgrounds with the tools to practice primary care. It also provides new hope to slightly disabled surgeons who comfortably practice adult out patient primary care and are still capable of diagnosing and treating patients in a primary care setting.

Program Snapshot

- 15-course online curriculum (180 hours) designed and written by UC San Diego School of Medicine professors and primary care physicians
- Online final examination and practical exam
- Up to 180 hours of AMA PRA Category 1 credits™ from the UC San Diego School of Medicine
- Graduate job placement assistance
- Tuition: \$9,750

Corporate Timeline

- May 2012: PRR founded; beta program begins
- June 2013: Curriculum and exams finalized; program open to medically licensed physicians nationwide
- January 2014: UC San Diego School of Medicine approves AMA PRA Category 1 credit™ for PRR course
